Colleen Hastings was born in 1961 to Thomas F. and Ester L. (Ring) Hastings. She was one of eight children (Kathleen, Guy, Mary Ann, Mark, Celeste, Patricia, and Rebecca) and grew up on Mill Street. She lived in a traditional large family in a time when all the families in the neighborhoods knew each other and elementary schools dotted the City by the Sea. Colleen is a 1981 graduate of Rogers High School. She is a lifelong parishioner of Saint Mary's Church.



During her years growing up in Newport, she spent much time at the Boys and Girls Club, a place her family was very active in. These times, and growing up in a large family, helped to teach her valuable life lessons.

After Rogers high school she attended the University of Rhode Island, graduating in 1985 with a B.A. in Communications and Spanish. She followed up URI with a law degree from Suffolk University Law School, graduating in 1991.

From 1993 to 2008 she was the President/Owner of the Family Law Center of Rhode Island. As if this was not a big enough job, she was also the Assistant City Solicitor for Newport from 1998 to 2007! She served as the Assistant Legal Counsel to Senate Majority Leader M. Teresa Paiva Weed from 2004 to 2007 and a Rhode Island Family Court Magistrate from 2007 to 2009. In 2009 she was sworn in as a Rhode Island District Court Associate Judge assigned to Newport County District Court where she currently presides.
